## How to Add Medications to Your TPN Bag



## IF YOUR TPN BAG LOOKS LIKE THIS...

- 1 Prescriber ordered medications to add to the TPN infusion will be added to the 1st port (on the bottom, far left).
- 2 Use the middle port to remove tab and then spike the bag with the infusion pump tubing.
- 3 The 3<sup>rd</sup> port on the bottom, far right) is used by the compounding pharmacy to make TPN infusion and should not be accessed by the patient or nurse.

## **IF YOUR TPN BAG LOOKS LIKE THIS...**

- 1 Prescriber ordered medications to add to the TPN infusion will be added to the 3<sup>rd</sup> port (on the bottom, far right).
- Use the 1st port (on bottom, far left) to remove tab and then spike the bag with the infusion pump tubing.
- The middle port is used by the compounding pharmacy to make TPN infusion and should not be accessed by the patient or nurse.
